We are excited to share the outcomes of two impactful Learning Teaching Training Activities (LTTs) held in Vilnius and Budapest, where we engaged in empowering 60 students with disabilities through a comprehensive 3-day training on inclusive education. These LTTs aimed to foster a more inclusive environment within educational settings and equip participants with the necessary tools to become advocates for diversity and inclusion.

LTA in Vilnius:

In Vilnius, Lithuania, our dedicated team conducted a dynamic LTT from November 6th to November 8th, 2023. Over the course of three days, 30 enthusiastic students with disabilities from various educational institutions participated in immersive workshops, discussions, and practical activities focused on inclusive training methods. Facilitators shared insights on creating accessible learning environments, adapting teaching techniques, and promoting peer support among students.



As we reflect on the success of these LTTs, we are inspired by the enthusiasm and dedication of all participants in fostering a more inclusive society. Moving forward, we remain committed to continuing our efforts to promote inclusive education and empower students with disabilities to thrive in educational settings worldwide.
