



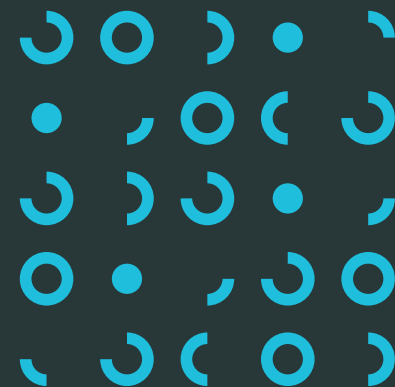

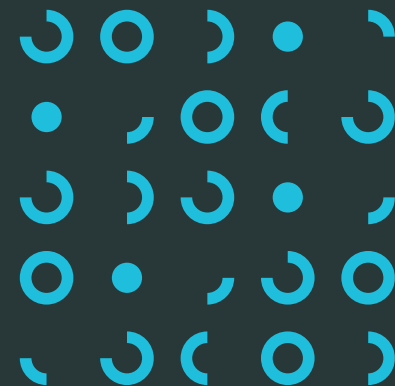

Useful information for the 2nd semester

- HSUP teams can consist of exactly 3 students (there may be more members but max. 3 students can receive scholarships)
- Matchmaking (team members, HSUP mentors) organized by HSUP central via the HSUP platform & online events
- Scholarship and other financial support:
 - 65.000 Ft/month/student (4 months, from March to June); scholarship contract coming up in March/April 2026)
 - Members of the 15 best teams selected for the HSUP Demo Day receives an additional 1 million HUF/person
- Watch out for obligatory & optional activities: mentoring, workshops and lectures by ELTE_xHSUP & NIÜ
 - Monthly reports: by April 1, 30, May 21 2026
 - Completion of Module-closing tests and submission of Progress Report (by May 21, 2026)
- Notifications, deadlines – sent as Neptun course mail and by email
- Purposefulness, foresight – forming teams, completing modules, materials to prepare etc.

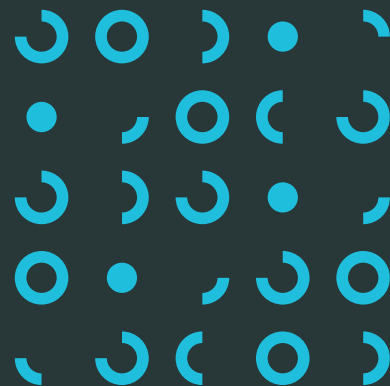

Q1: Can changes be introduced to the one-pagers submitted in December?

A: The text can be changed minimally, but the problem and solution should be the same as what the students submitted in December when uploaded.

During the semester, there will of course be an opportunity to pivot ideas, but at this initial stage, no one should change the project yet.

Q2: On what basis are teams selected for the Demo Day?

A: They are selected by a team of external experts organised by the HSUP central office, and the basis of selection is the progress reports and mentor review. The requirements will be shared with students by their mentors. Also, you will have to prepare an introduction video of your team and your project, which also makes for a basis for evaluation.

Q3: The level of goals achievable within the given time frame varies between teams; what are the expectations for the semester and how can we define the proper development of the project in general terms?

A: All teams should have a minimum viable product by the end of the semester, which, of course, does not have to be a tangible item. If you have a clear concept on what your product will really be, it will be taken into account. This is what you will need to achieve. Also, you will have to work on a more detailed business plan, outreach plan and on the product itself.
