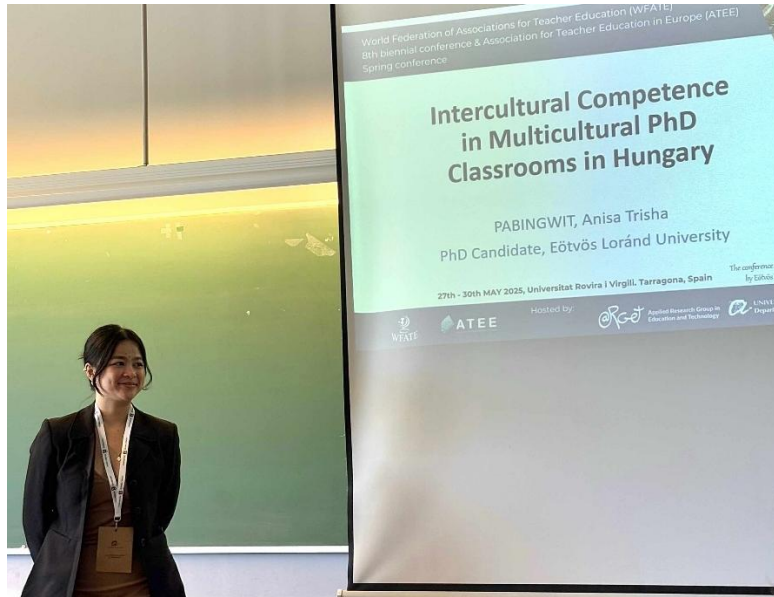
**Location:** Tarragona, Spain

I had the opportunity to attend and present as the main author at the “Teacher Education in a Global World” Conference, held from May 27 to 30, 2024, at Rovira i Virgili University in Tarragona, Spain. Organized by the Association for Teacher Education in Europe (ATEE) in collaboration with the World Federation of Associations for Teacher Education (WFATE), this international event brought together researchers, educators, and practitioners to discuss current and future challenges in global education.



The conference focused on sustainable and equitable teaching and learning practices, with an emphasis on the role of teacher research in shaping global educational contexts. I presented an article entitled “Intercultural Competence in Multicultural Classrooms: Perceptions of International PhD Students in Hungarian Universities,” which is part of my doctoral research under the European Doctorate in Teacher Education (EDiTE) program at ELTE. This presentation allowed me to contribute to scholarly dialogue on teacher education in higher education and receive valuable feedback from international peers. The experience was not only beneficial for my professional development as an international doctoral student, but also enhanced ELTE’s visibility in the global academic community. The knowledge and connections I gained during the event will inform my ongoing research and support future collaborations.
