BASIC SCIENCE STUDIES

COGNITIVE AND AFFECTIVE PSYCHOLOGY

perception, attention, learning, memory, thinking, consciousness, motivation and emotion, etc.

PERSONALITY PSYCHOLOGY

theories of personality, development and functioning of the self, and control- and coping processes, etc.

SOCIAL PSYCHOLOGY

social cognition, perceiving individuals and groups, belief systems, attitude dynamics, etc.

DEVELOPMENTAL PSYCHOLOGY

human motor, language and cognitive development, socialisation across the life span, etc.

BORDERING SCIENCES AND RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

physiology and anatomy, economics and behavioral sciences, culture and society, statistics, evolutionary psychology, behavioral genetics, etc.
