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## CALL FOR APPLICATION

### ELTE International Student Advisory Committee for 2025/2026

#### 1. What is the International Student Advisory Committee?

The International Student Advisory Committee is a student organization aiming to make the University a more inclusive space for ELTE Citizens of all backgrounds.

Its main role is to offer the representation of international students at ELTE while covering the much needed aspects through:

- Helping the international students on an individual level, and answering their questions regarding the University and even everyday life;
- Representing the international community during various events, making connections and cooperating with third party organizations and so on.
- Organizing activities tailored to the interest and needs of ELTE Citizens (academic and social events): Cultural Connection Day, International Freshmen Camp, skill-development workshops, and more.

#### 2. Why should you decide to be part of the International Student Advisory Committee?

- **Expand your student network:** Build an exciting student network across the university.
- **Boost your CV with valuable experience:** Gain work experience to give your CV extra weight (e.g. leadership, event planning, content management, etc.).
- **Develop your skills that employers appreciate:** Sharpen your communication and presentation skills, event and time management and increase your confidence.
- **Trainings:** Receive trainings and coaching throughout the role.
- **Reference letter:** Receive a reference letter based on your performance.
- **Certificate:** If you actively participate in the program, you are entitled to receive a certificate at the end of the academic year 2025/2026.
- **Team building events:** We will periodically organize leisure activities for the Committee

**Please note that this role is on a voluntary basis and not intended as a form of employment.**



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### 3. Who is eligible:

- Must be a full-time degree-seeking student enrolled at ELTE, with an active student status **until the end of the academic year 2025/2026**.
- Students at bachelor, master and doctoral levels are eligible.
- Must have **completed at least one semester** at ELTE.
- Student should be based at ELTE for the academic year 2025/2026 and not on academic exchange abroad.

Essential skills:

- **Language skills:** English is essential, Hungarian and other languages are a plus
- **Good time management**
- **Friendly and approachable**
- **Strong driving force to make ELTE an even better place**
- **Familiar with the different concepts of internationalization, inclusion, diversity, social work, etc.**

Extra qualities we would love to see:

- **Soft skills:** strong interpersonal and organizational skills
- Ability to **take initiatives and lead them**
- Good **team player**
- **Digital marketing skills**
- **Event planning and management**
- **Connections with external parties** (associations, embassies, organizations, etc.)

### 4. Responsibilities

- Representing ELTE international in external and internal events
- Collaborate with the ELTE student unions (faculty student union, university student union, dormitory student union)
- Create and hold several events in the BoYL community space and your faculties
- Be present at office hours and **mandatory** meetings/trainings

**Remember, you are not alone in this. Onboarding, guidance and support from Committee members and the International Strategy Office is part of the ISAC strategic plans.**

**The exact tasks will be determined during the first onboarding bootcamp, depending on the opportunities, and the needs of the community.**

**Please note, that if you continuously neglect your duties as in the Committee, the University will unilaterally terminate your position!**

- c. A motivation letter including your personal qualities, your daily experience as international student at ELTE; thoughts/ideas on the process of internationalization; potential initiatives to bridge the gap (if any); and your commitment)

**Optional Supporting Materials:** If you have any certificates, awards, or other documents that demonstrate your qualifications, and if you have connections with organizations which can support our scope, please include them.

### 6. Selection criteria and selection process:

Applicants must meet the eligibility criteria and must have essential skills.

We welcome applications from Hungarian and International students of all disciplines and all faculties. Applications from diverse backgrounds are encouraged to apply.

During the selection process, we aim to create the diverse and balanced representation of different ELTE faculties, degree programs, scholarships, nationalities, regions and cultures.

Shortlisted candidates will be invited for an interview at the latest beginning of June.

The selected candidates will be notified by mid-June.
