SOCIAL AND ORGANISATIONAL PSYCHOLOGY PROGRAMME

Provides a sound theoretical background for studying social psychology: from state-of-the-art scientific research to analysing psychological aspects of processes in society in general as well as in economy, public opinion, education, and the media.

Knowledge in social psychology, public opinion and market research, policy analysis and political counselling, advertisement and marketing, mediation.

Ability to conduct social psychological research, analyse political-economic processes and do consultancy, and public communication at a high level of expertise.



DEVELOPMENTAL AND CLINICAL CHILD PSYCHOLOGY PROGRAMME

Provides up-to-date knowledge on **typical** and **atypical** development.

Provides methodological skills in **clinical** and **research work with children**.

Offers professional opportunities for students to practise their knowledge in:

- our **clinical** fields (covering a broad range of institutions for treating children and adolescents) **and**
- our **research groups** (investigating infant and child development and mental disorders).

Prepares students to continue their studies towards three different types of postgraduate specialist degree in psychology and PhD studies.

CLINICAL AND HEALTH PSYCHOLOGY PROGRAMME

Provides knowledge and skills to both **diagnostic, counseling, intervention practices** and **research** in clinical and health psychology.

Prepares students to work in **mental health clinics** and various health promotion programmes.

Prepares students to continue their studies towards **PhD** in clinical and/or health psychology.

WORK AND ORGANISATIONAL PSYCHOLOGY PROGRAMME

Establish a complex theoretical and practical background for understanding and developing leaders, work teams and organisations. Students will be able to work as OD consultants, leadership trainers and coaches, and as HRD managers in organisations.



After successful completion of the programme students will have the:

- Knowledge of organisational strategy, structure and processes; leadership and organisational psychology; personnel psychology; health, wellbeing and productivity in the workplace; organisational and group dynamics; intercultural management and communication; behavioral economics;
- Ability to conduct organisational, team and individual assessments; to manage organisational development projects; to deliver 1to1 and team coaching; to facilitate workshops and to work with learning and development groups, to develop and run research projects in leadership and organisational psychology, and to measure the impact of learning and development interventions.

COGNITIVE PSYCHOLOGY PROGRAMME

A **research intensive programme** focused on the comprehension of perception, attention, memory and numerical cognition, and language from a developmental and a neuro-cognitive perspective.

INTENSIVE LABORATORY PRACTICE INCLUDES

- **cognitive neuroscience** specialisation investigating electrophysiological and functional changes
- behavioural correlates of perceptual and cognitive abilities
- **cognitive developmental specialisation** investigating the underlying neural mechanisms of the development of cognition and social learning

COUNSELLING AND EDUCATIONAL PSYCHOLOGY PROGRAMME

Provides sound theoretical background to build competences both in the fields of **diagnosis** and **other related fields**.

Provides knowledge and skills both in the fields of **individual and group counselling, family counselling** that make our students able to initiate change in group at individual and social levels.

Our main scope is to train **practicing experts** in the fields of school psychology, vocational guidance, carrier counselling, crisis intervention, and other related fields.
