What is CHARM-EU?

CHARM-EU is a European University Alliance between the University of Barcelona, Trinity College Dublin, Utrecht University, the University of Montpellier and Eötvös Loránd University Budapest. From 2023, the alliance counts with three new members: Åbo Akademi University of Turku, Julius-Maximilians University Würzburg and the Ruhr West University of Applied Sciences.

CHARM-EU represents a Challenge-Driven, Accessible, Research-based and Mobile model for the co-creation of a European University aligned with the European Values, the European Green Deal and the sustainable development goals (SDGs).

CHARM-EU not only runs the first ever European joint degree program (**Master's in Global Challenges for Sustainability**), but also develops innovative methods in education and research **together with important societal actors**.

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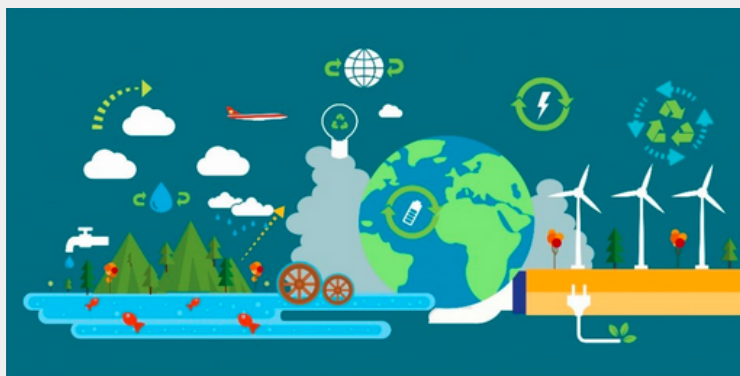

During the final Capstone phase, students collaborate with the extended network to co-create knowledge and solutions to sustainability challenges related to the UN Sustainable Development Goals.
