Stonehenge: Past, present, and futures

This lecture focuses on the internationally known prehistoric World Heritage Site of Stonehenge in central southern Britain. It will review the results of recent investigations within and around the monument in relation to our understanding of the development and use of the site. Attention will also be directed to the on-going issues of managing and presenting what has become an icon for prehistoric Europe within the context of today's tourism industry and international conservation conventions. Finally, we will look to the future and consider how Stonehenge and other comparable places might be used to help address current societally significant issues such as health and well-being.

Timothy Darvill OBE is Professor of Archaeology in the Department of Archaeology and Anthropology at Bournemouth University, UK. His research interests focus on the Neolithic of Atlantic northwest Europe, and archaeological resource management. In 2008 he directed excavations inside Stonehenge, and has also excavated in Malta, Germany, Russia, England, Wales, and the Isle of Man.
