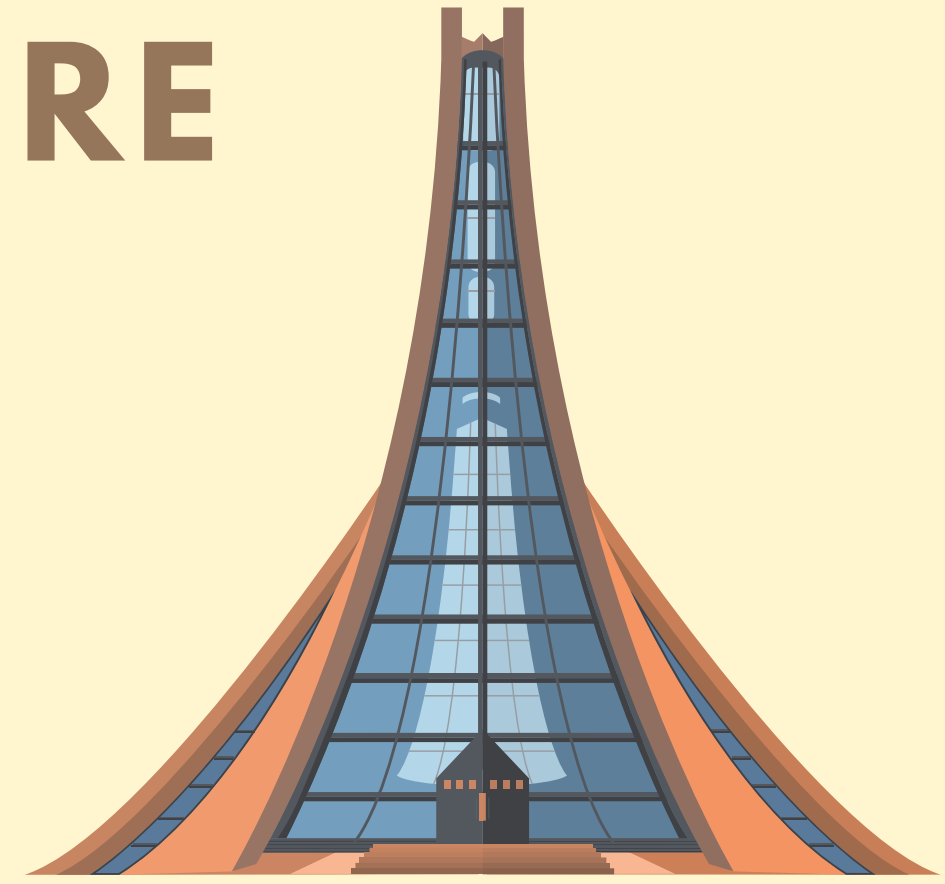


2024 TUNGSHAI UNIVERSITY LANGUAGE AND CULTURE SUMMER PROGRAM

WHAT WE GONNA DO IN THE PROGRAM?

Chinese language courses

We will provide 36-hour Chinese language courses during the three-week program. With the intensive courses and the instructions from the lecturers, this will be a great opportunity to improve your language ability!



Special Lectures

Special lectures will be arranged three times in the three-week program for students to look into Taiwanese Business, Taiwanese Culture, Taiwan's political situation.

Field Trip in Taichung and in Taipei

Two-day trip in Taipei and one day trip in Taichung for participants to experience Taiwanese local life and get to know Taiwanese Folk Art.

Taiwanese Culture Experience

We will invite lecturers to teach students how to make Chinese Knot and Paper Cutting, allowing students to experience the beauty of Taiwanese art.

Buddy for Extracurricular Activities

We will match participants with THU buddy students for culture exchange. When having cultural excursion, THU buddy will assist participants with translation and respond to their needs. Furthermore, during the short-term program, flexible time is arranged for participants to meet with their language partners.

- Note:
 1. English and Chinese will be the medium of instruction.
 2. Student will take different class level according to the result of placement test.
Placement test will be taken online before the start of the class.
 3. Students who have completed the program will be issued official learning report.



ABOUT OUR PROGRAM



Eligibility

1. The program is open to students currently enrolled in any of the Tunghai's partner universities and who have been recommended by their respective faculty.
2. The program is open to students who possess a beginner's or an intermediate level of Chinese language ability i.e., students who have successfully passed the 3rd level of the TOCFL or HSK. Students with the 4th level of TOCFL will be highly likely to feel the Chinese class too easy.

Application Procedure

1. Nominated by the partner universities.
2. Complete the online application form with required documents uploaded by deadline.
3. Late application will not be accepted.

Cancellation Policy

1. 90% of the program fee will be refunded for a cancellation before the refund date.
2. Paid fees will not be refundable after the refund date.

Accommodation

Student will be arranged to stay at THU Alumni House or student dormitory located on campus. According to the the availability of the on-campus dormitory, OIR will keep participants updated about the accommodation information. The accomodation rooms are shared by 2 students with twin beds, shared restrooms, shared shower facilities and air conditioning.

Program Fees

Including the fees for registration, accommodation, Chinese language courses, culture classes, field trips, and miscellaneous charge. Fees for flight tickets and meals are not included.
